Hike Description: Hike to pretty Snoquera Falls, a delightful hike about 1.7 miles to the falls. The elevation gain is about 900 feet and rocky. We will see a variety of trees and forest flowers on the first part of the hike. In the open area near the falls are orchids and a variety of colorful flowers, where we will have lunch.

Any special requirements: Senior Pass, Annual National pass or a National Forest pass is needed to park at this trail head. A day pass to a National Forest can be purchased for \$5 online at 'National Forest Recreation epass', one needed per car.

Wear good hiking shoes. Byrna suggests that those with hiking sticks, bring them and she can bring extra to loan. Bring a sack lunch. Water and cookies will be provided at end of hike.

Directions: Meet at the trailhead at 10 AM or carpool from Sheri's at 112th and Canyon Rd at 8:30 AM. Byrna drives a red Subaru and can take 3-4 people. Come with a few dollars to pay driver's gas or come with a full tank of gas to drive riders.

Driving directions to trailhead: Head east on H-410, through Enumclaw, through Greenwater and past Dalles Campground. Take a left into Camp Sheppard parking lot. It is 1 1/4 hour drive from Puyallup.
