**Directions:** Far Reaches Farm is located at 1818 Hastings Ave, Port Townsend. Allow about two hours for the drive.

It's simple—enter Port Townsend from Highway 20 (aka Sims Way):

- Take a left on Sheridan Street, just past the QFC, before going down the hill.
- Go 3/4 of a mile to stop sign on 19th Street.
- Proceed straight through intersection to the next stop sign at Hastings Street.
- Turn left onto Hastings.
- Go 1/3 mile and turn right at the 1818 driveway, look for our polka-dotted mailbox.
- Park in the field at the back of our property.
