Hike Description: Easy walk through lush native plant woods along Nisqually River.

Directions: From Tacoma go south on I-5 to WA-512 and then east to Route 7. Go south to Roy Y and take right fork on WA-507 toward Yelm. After crossing the bridge over the Nisqually River, take an immediate right onto a gravel road at the blue sign that says Yelm Shoreline Nature Reserve just before Stewart's Meat shop on the left. Parking is down road on left.

From Olympia, go north on I-5 to Mounts Rd SW/Old Pacific Highway SE and turn east. Continue on Old Pacific Hwy SE and take Reservation Rd SE (WA-510E) which becomes Yelm Highway SE. Continue onto WA-507. Just before crossing the bridge over Nisqually River and opposite Stewart's Meat shop on the right, turn left, turn onto a gravel road at the blue sign that says Yelm Shoreline Nature Reserve. Parking is down road on left.
