Directions:

Going north on HWY 16, take the Burnham Dr. exit. At the first traffic circle, take the 5th exit onto Burnham Dr. NW (crossing over HWY 16); at the next traffic circle take the first exit to stay on Burnham Dr. NW

Going south on HWY 16, take the Burnham Dr exit. At the traffic circle take the first exit onto Burnham Dr. NW

Follow brown park signs. At the stop sign turn left onto Sehmel Dr. NW. Go 1.5 miles and turn left onto 78th Ave NW. Go about 50 yards and turn left into Sehmel Homestead Park.
