Hike Description: To celebrate Pierce County Trails Day, we'll explore some of the 4 miles of trails through abundant native plants, admire the old growth conifers and enjoy the wildlife. Some trails are steep but depending on participants' desires, we'll decide which trails to trek.

Any special requirements: Dress for the weather and wear good hiking shoes. We will have snacks and water. Plant lists will be available.

Directions: From Route 16, take the Burnham Drive exit and go west (crossing back over Route 16 around 2 traffic circles if you are coming from the south or taking the first right exit in the traffic circle if you are coming from the north). At the stop sign turn left onto Sehmel Rd, go about 1/4 mile and turn left onto Bujacich Rd. Park entrance is about 200 yards on the left opposite the fire station entrance. Parking at the fire station is recommended.
